**Narrator:** Many of our Lambton boys have journeyed to foreign lands to assist with oil exploration.



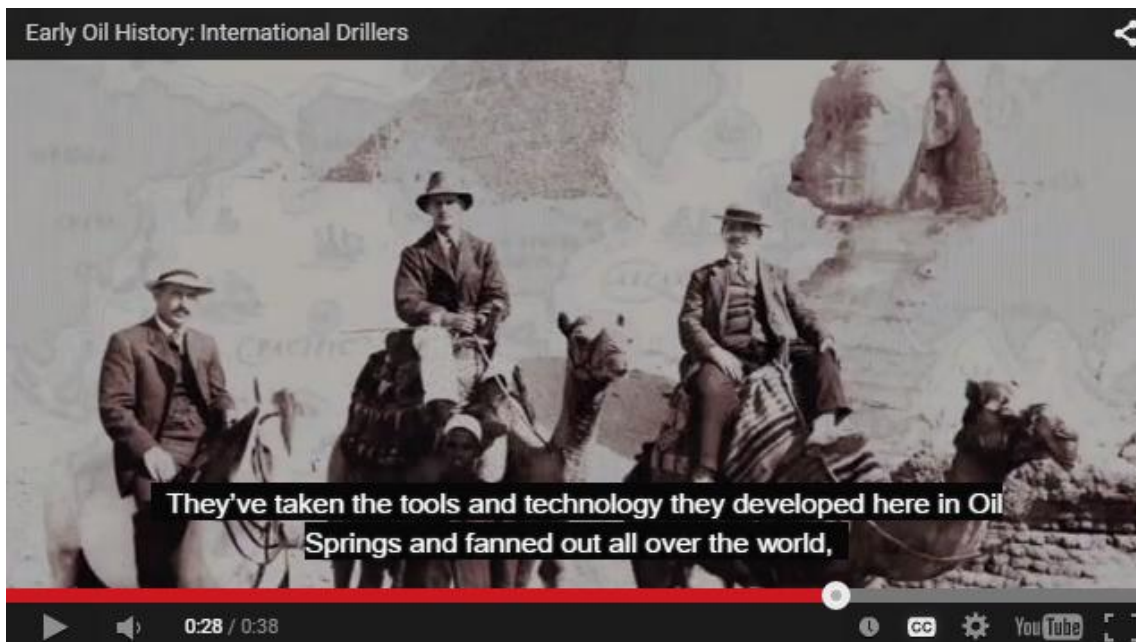
